<b>5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:</b> Energy Conservation Program: Energy Conservation Standards for Commercial Refrigerators, Freezers, and Refrigerator-Freezers; (112 page(s), in English)
<b>6. Description of content:</b> Notice of proposed rulemaking and announcement of public meeting - The <a href="#">Energy Policy and Conservation Act, as amended</a> ("EPCA"), prescribes energy conservation standards for various consumer equipment and certain commercial and industrial equipment, including commercial refrigerators, freezers, and refrigerator-freezers (" <a href="#">commercial refrigeration equipment</a> " or "CRE"). EPCA also requires the U.S. Department of Energy ("DOE" "the Department") to periodically determine whether more stringent standards would be technologically feasible and economically justified, and would result in significant energy savings. In this notice of proposed rulemaking ("NOPR"), DOE proposes new and amended energy conservation standards for CRE, and also announces a public meeting to receive comment on these proposed standards and associated analyses and results.  DOE will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, 7 November 2023, from <a href="#">10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Eastern Time</a> , in Washington, DC. This meeting will also be broadcast as a webinar.
