Description: Products covered: Energy and heat transfer engineering in general (ICS code(s): 27.010); Internal combustion engines (ICS code(s): 27.020); Hydrogen technologies, (ICS code(s): 27.075); Passenger cars. Caravans and light trailers (ICS code(s): 43.100)

This addendum concerns the notification of the Ministerial Decree No.466/2025 (1 page, in Arabic) that gives the producers and importers a six -months transitional period to abide by the Egyptian Standard ES 9001 for "Fuel/Energy economy and Emissions label requirements for Vehicles of category M1 "; (37 page(s), in Arabic).

It should be noted that the Ministerial Decree No. 7 /2025 (2 pages, in Arabic) which was formerly notified in G/TBT/N/EGY/465/Add.1 dated 11 February 2025, mandated among others the earlier version of this Standard, and the draft of this standard was formerly notified in [G/TBT/N/EGY/465](#) dated 4 April 2024.

Worth mentioning is that this standard has been formulated according to National Studies.
