The following communication, dated 4 June 2026, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the United States of America.

Title: Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards No. 303, Fuel System Integrity of Compressed Natural Gas Vehicles

Description: On 30 May 2025, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) published a notice of proposed rulemaking (NPRM) (notified as G/TBT/N/USA/2204) proposing to remove obsolete text in Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 303, "Fuel System Integrity of Compressed Natural Gas Vehicles." The agency received no comment on the proposed changes to FMVSS No. 303, and therefore the agency is adopting the changes in this final rule.

Effective date: 6 July 2026.

Petitions for Reconsideration: If you wish to petition for reconsideration of this rule, your petition must be received by 20 July 2026.
